TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Hockey Academy reserves the right to change the day and /or time of practices/games/lessons.
2. Refunds and pro-rates may be considered if player/student is injured and therefore cannot skate. **Players who are suspended or ejected from any Programs are NOT entitled to a refund, exchange or pro rate of any kind.** Academy students who cannot attend a regularly scheduled class may take a make-up class if available, provided that it is before the end of the current semester. No refunds or credits will be made for absences or classes missed by the student. Some classes may not have make-up options. A 10% bookkeeping fee will be charged for cancellations. ***NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN AFTER THE END OF THE SEMESTER AND ALL REFUNDS ISSUED PRIOR TO THE END OF THE SEMESTER WILL EXPIRE 30 DAYS AFTER THE SEMESTERS END.**
3. The parent or guardian agrees to abide the terms of installment payments (if offered by the Academy) and agrees to make payments upon scheduled due dates, without a reminder form the Hockey Academy. If Parent or Guardian fails to remit payment to the on scheduled due dates; the above player may be suspended from the Hockey Academy Program.
4. Parent and skater assume all risk and danger incidental to ice skating in general, and the game of hockey in particular. These risks and dangers include, but are not limited to, the danger of being injured by pucks, hockey sticks and other players. The parent or guardian also agrees that the Hockey Academy is not responsible for loss of or damage to any personal property.
5. Helmet (HECC approved) with facemask required for Hockey 1 classes. Full equipment required for Hockey 2 & 3 classes, all team play, drop-ins, stick/ pucks, clinics and camps. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Street Hockey equipment is not acceptable.
6. Teams may be joined together if a minimum of fifteen players per team is not achieved. Each team will have an average of fifteen (15) players, two goalies and a standby waiting list.
7. Photo & Video release: Pictures and/or Videos will be taken at various times in the semester for various uses including but not limited to bulletin boards, brochures, and advertisements.
